

Agreement Protocol

Step One:

Not later than 72 hours before a Household Goods Carrier (HGC) is to travel through the two covered segment locations (see map), you will submit electronically or by fax a signed Agreement to the Department of Transportation and to the Garberville area CHP office a copy of the Interim Access Agreement for Household Goods Carriers. You will need the name of the HGC, your California PUC number/DOT number, a copy of the required insurance policy and certificate of insurance.

Step Two:

Within 24 hours of your arrival at the locations you will call or email the Garberville CHP area office at (707-923-2155) or (ajager@chp.ca.gov).

Step Three:

Meet the escort at a designated time and location. Travel safely.

In the Event of Accidents:

You must report any accidents in these two locations to the Department of Transportation within 30 days by sending a fax to the following telephone number (707-445-6314).

Inclement Weather:

You need to check ahead with the Highway Patrol to determine if there are any limitations due to weather as required in the Agreement.
